The purpose of our Home-School Agreement

All schools are required to have a home-school agreement to formalise the working partnership between the school, our pupils and their families.

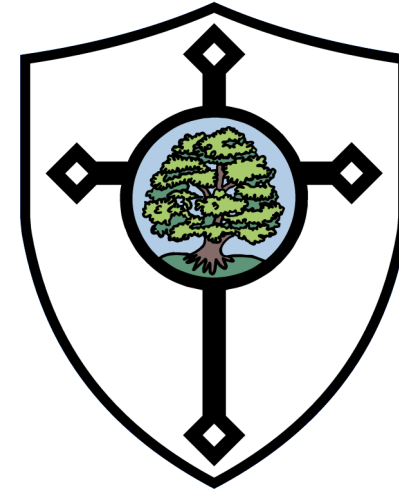
We have set out of school aims and values in this document along with a number of key expectations.

By signing the agreement the school, parents and pupils are all committing to do their best to ensure that we work together to help the child make the most of their time in school.

This home-school agreement will be reviewed and signed annually to ensure it is up to date and relevant. From time to time, the school may remind pupils of the expectations they have agreed to. We have chosen the wording carefully but some further simplification may be required when explaining the agreement to younger children.

Please note that all staff should be treated with respect at all times. The Governors will not tolerate any verbal abuse towards staff by parents/carers. This could include aggressive behaviour such as swearing, shouting, standing in personal space, intimidating and/or gesticulating at a teacher. In the rare event of this occurring, Governors will write to the parents concerned. In the event of any physical assault, the police will be informed.

Parents should be aware that any defamatory remarks made on any social media site, where a member of staff is named, may result in the police being informed.
