Our United Kingdom	Countries, capital cities and borders on a simple map.	Children to recognise, remember and locate countries and capitals.
The British Passport	Recognise features of the passport, make their own passport, take their own photograph. Compare with another from elsewhere in the world.	Recognise features of the passport. What tells us it's British?
Our People	Recognise facial features and colours. African, Chinese, White European. Briefly mention others – Eskimo, Sami from around Europe.	Difference/similarity/all people of the world. Living together peacefully. Areas/Regions. Lancashire – Birmingham etc.
Our Government	Name the parties, senior politicians. Where they meet, how they are selected. House of Commons / Lords.	To know the Prime Minister – 10 Downing Street. To begin to understand the election process.
Music	Beatles music. Name the members of the Beatles.	Famous songs. Penny Lane, Yellow Submarine etc. Be able to sing along.
Liverpool	Port, docks, Liver Building, River Mersey. Football teams, Merseyside, Cathedrals	Picture gallery of all main features that children recognise.
Money	Pounds / Pence – Euro. Comparisons / Differences.	Recognise that not everyone in Europe uses the Pound.
Our School	Know history of the school, look at floor plans, know how many children attend, find out how far everyone lives from school – who lives the closest and furthest away?	Know that our school serves not just people in Aspull and appreciate why this is.
Local town/city	Haigh Hall visits, library, local shops	Children know what is available for them in their local area
Tourism	Children to discuss and recognise one tourist site.
