

Sports Premium Plan 2017 / 18

At Lyneham Primary School we are proud of the wide range of high quality sport and healthy living opportunities we provide that help to keep our children active and healthy.

We promote a highly positive and inclusive learning environment which enables all children to take part in and enjoy sports and an active lifestyle whilst maintaining a healthy approach to competition.

The school takes part in a number of league competitions with local schools including netball and football and the children have enjoyed considerable success in these competitions.

The school receives an annual grant for PE based on the number of pupils on our school roll. We invest a significant proportion of our PE grant funding in our full time specialist sports coach. Mr Thorne teaches every class in the school during the course of the week and also runs lunch-time, after-school and holiday sports clubs. Mr Thorne teaches all aspects of PE skills and has introduced a wide range of sports so that all children can take part and enjoy success playing alongside their peers. Mr Thorne also provides very popular holiday sports clubs.

Mr Thorne works closely alongside our PE leader Miss Durston to provide professional development opportunities for teachers and TAs to develop their PE and sports teaching skills.

This year we have also used some of our PE grant to promote active healthy and safe lifestyles via digital TVs in our playground and reception area. The programme content on the channel changes termly and includes interactive activities and dance; introducing new sports and active games; the importance of healthy lifestyle choices; healthy eating; anti-bullying and on-line safety. In 2017/18 we will be running a daily outdoor Wake and Shake programme for children and families on the playground every morning via the digital TV monitor and led by school staff.
