Dear Parent/Guardian

To support our Tomorrow's World topic, I have organised a trip to Magna in Rotherham, on Thursday 23<sup>rd</sup> November 2017. This visit is a full day and children will be working in groups to discover more about the topic and taking part in an education session with Magna staff.

We intend to depart from school at 9.00AM, so please could children be in school at the slightly earlier time of 8.45 on that day. We will be returning at approximately 4.00 p.m. The children will need to bring a packed lunch and drink as usual and will need to be dressed in **school uniform (sweatshirt/ cardigan, suitable trousers and footwear)**.

In order to run this visit we have to raise the cost of tickets, entry and transport, which works out at £22.65 per child per place.

Under the requirements of the Education Reform Act, 1988 (as consolidated in the Education Act 1996) we can only raise the cost of the (visit, activity, etc.) by voluntary contribution. There is no obligation to contribute and children will not be treated differently according to whether or not any contribution has been made.

**However, the visit can only go ahead if the level of support is sufficient.**
