ACCESSIBILITY STRATEGY

Reviewed: October 2017 – Ratified 7th November 2017

Rationale

- With foresight, the schools must enable ease of access for pupils and parents with a variety of needs. This means that the schools must successfully cater for all pupils and their families.

Statement of Intent

- To ensure full access to the school curriculum, enrichment activities and trips.
- To provide suitable access to the school building and grounds.
- To present all information in accessible formats for pupils and parents.
- To allocate adequate resources to implement strategies within a reasonable time.
- To take into account preferences expressed by pupil or parents.

Strategies

- The accessibility plan will be completed by a designated committee and reviewed regularly.
- Governors will examine the generated Health and Safety report.
- Any complaints will be heard by the Governing Body in accordance with our current complaints procedure.
- The needs of any new pupils will be communicated and catered for through enhanced provision as required.
- Parents/carers who are unable to access written communication will be contacted verbally.
