As a parents/carers we will:

- Ensure my child attends school regularly and punctually, and inform the school of the reason in case of their absence
- Make sure my child wears appropriate clothing in line with the school's dress code
- Support the school's ethos, behaviour management policy and procedures for ensuring a safe and secure environment
- Attend consultations with the class teacher or arrange an alternative time if this is not possible
- Promote a positive attitude towards education and use discretion when discussing issues or grievances in front of children
- Work in partnership with the school to ensure my child develops an understanding and respect for the traditions, cultures and beliefs of others
- Make early contact with school to discuss matters that might affect my child's progress, happiness or behaviour
- Take an active interest in my child's learning
