End of Year Results 2017

In 2016, the end of year assessments were changed to reflect a more challenging primary curriculum. Below is our school's performance against the national averages. Whilst the scores appear to be a reduction in percentages working at the expected level compared to previous years, the government has recognised that these results are in no way comparable due to the changes in the complexity of the curriculum.

These figures show the pupils who achieved the expected standard or higher in all three subject areas.

	Percentage of pupils who achieved the expected standard or above in reading, writing and maths	Percentage of pupils who achieved a higher standard in reading, writing and maths
CCJ 2017	59%	14%
Nationally 2017	61%	9%

These figures show the average score in reading and maths. This score is known as the reading 'scaled score'. The expected standard is a score of 100 or more. The higher standard is 110 or more.

These scores show how much progress pupils made in reading, writing and maths between the end of key stage 1 and the end of key stage 2, compared to pupils across England who got similar results at the end of key stage 1.
