

## Sports Premium Expenditure: St Joseph's Catholic Primary School

### Report: Academic Year 2015 – 2016

#### Statement

The DfE have made available an £8,000 lump sum per school and £5 per pupil funding to promote and develop the teaching of primary PE and increase opportunities for inter-school sport and competition.

#### Summary and Objectives of Pupil Premium Spending

Schools must spend the additional funding on improving their provision of PE and sport, but they will have the freedom to choose how they do this.
