Last week was a very busy week in school, thank you for all your support and well done for supporting our children to achieve great attendance, 97.6%, so far this school year. Excellent effort!!

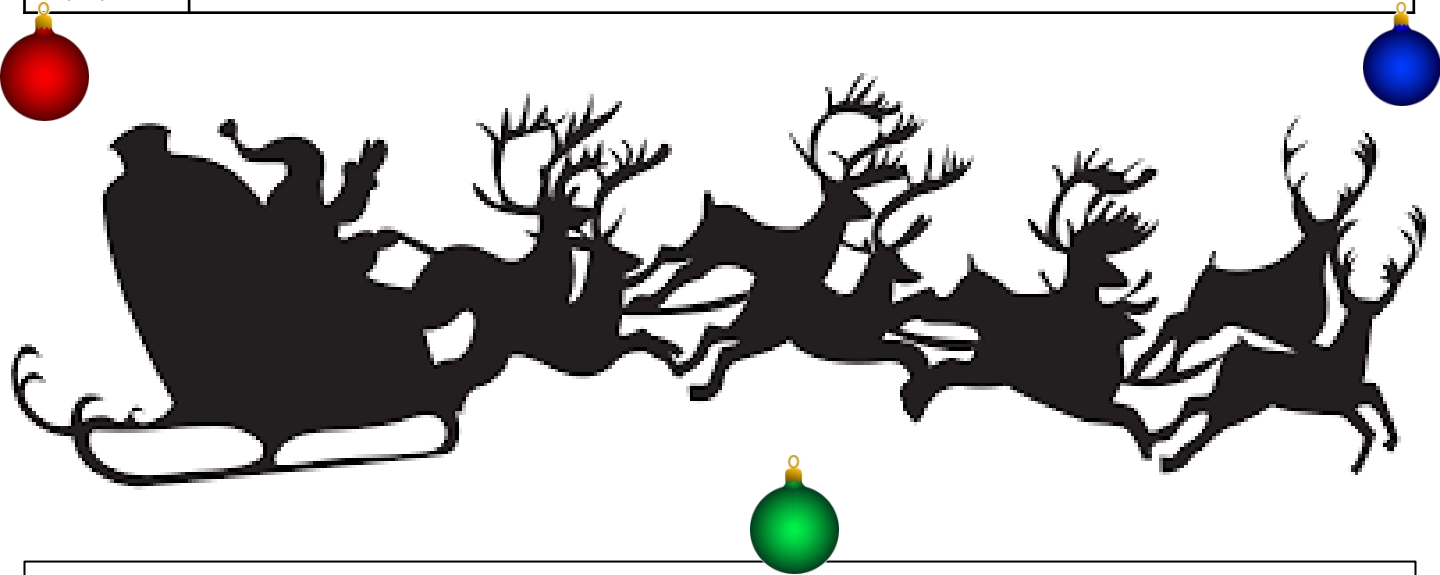
