

English

In English we will look at the features of and practise writing:

- Reports, persuasive texts and instructions.
- Different forms of poetry.
- Narratives and description.

Our English will be linked closely to our topic work.

In addition to this, we will be covering many of the year three spelling and grammar objectives.

Maths

In maths we will be focusing on place value of three digit numbers, mental fluency in adding and subtracting, as well as written fluency in adding and subtracting. We will be using estimating skills, counting forwards and backwards in ones, tens and hundreds and practising the 2, 3, 4, 5, 8 and 10 times tables.

RE

Our focus in RE throughout the year will be Christianity and Hinduism.

Science: In science we will focus on 'animals, including humans' and 'investigating plants'.

The children will be using a lot of scientific enquiry based skills, including: setting up practical investigations, recording evidence, asking questions, observing, explaining, making predictions and drawing conclusions.



Charlie and the Chocolate Factory



Topic

We will be learning about the origins of chocolate- including its history and where it comes from.

The children will be using maps to locate countries and focus on their physical and human features.

They will also look at different artefacts that link to our topic. This will introduce comparing clothing, leisure activities and artefacts from different countries and from the past.

PE

Over this term, the children will take part in two PE lessons a week. The children will be taking part in basketball, gymnastics and dance.
