Edward – “It is really good you should all go!”

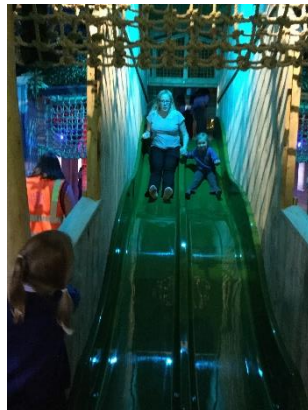
Molly – “There are lots of ropes to climb on to keep fit!”
