Dear Parents,

Welcome back! Thank you for your attendance at parents' evening. I hope that you enjoyed looking at your child's books and seeing the varied curriculum that we provide at Shade. I know from my classroom visits that our children are really engaged with their learning across all subjects. We welcome your feedback re our tracking and assessment system and will tweak the colours in order to avoid confusion between red and orange. As I explained in my letter, the Key Performance Indicators are for the end of the year that each child is in and if they are secure in 85% or above of them in July, then they would be considered to be working securely within that year group. At this point we would expect children to be developing their skill in many of these areas. Skills are not taught as one offs but are returned to many times in different ways to ensure that true learning has occurred. Children are more likely to be secure in very specific mathematical skills as compared to a reading or writing skill, which is built upon as the year progresses.

You should have received a Key Stage Newsletter outlining all the Christmas Events for your child. Please look in book bags for letters, (there were a number left on benches in the hall and in the cloakroom!)
