

## Pupil Premium Action Plan 2017-18

In 2017-18 St Martin's Infant and Junior Schools received £80,780 for Pupil Premium. Our plans for how this will be spent are outlined below.

Developing writing skills through use of Clicker 7	Training for staff to use Clicker 7 as appropriate. Identified children receive support to develop skills in <b>writing</b> .	All year groups depending on need	£4420
Targeted small group work	Small groups of children receive targeted support for short, regular sessions over a period of time. This includes <b>language</b> and <b>English skills</b> .	Early Years	£2,600
Play sessions	To develop the <b>social and emotional skills</b> for children through play and to enable them to communicate more effectively with each other and in their <b>writing</b> .	Early Years & Year 1	£3,780
Family Fisher Trust (FFT) with a teacher	FFT training for identified staff plus purchase of resources. Identified children receive 1:1 support to develop their <b>English skills</b> .	Year 1 & 2	£4,623
Targeted individual or small group work with a teacher	Individuals or small groups of children are withdrawn from their class and receive targeted support for short, regular sessions. This includes <b>maths</b> and <b>English skills</b> .	All year groups depending on need	£17072
Read, Write Inc (RWI)	Read, Write Inc training for identified staff and purchase of resources as appropriate. Identified children/small groups receive targeted support for short, regular sessions over a period of time to develop their <b>English skills</b> , particularly <b>phonics</b> .	Y2-6 depending on need and targeted intervention	£4,384
Numicon	Numicon training sessions for identified staff plus purchase of resources as appropriate. Identified children/small groups receive targeted support to develop their <b>maths skills</b> .	All year groups depending on need	£1435
Additional TA support and resources	To ensure children stay focused and on task to enable progress across the curriculum. For intervention programmes including: SNAP on <b>Maths, Phonics</b> support, Guided <b>Reading</b> , Developing <b>Written Language</b> , Time for <b>Talk</b> , Precision Teaching of identified skills.	All year groups depending on need and targeted intervention	£12,314

Support from Family Support Worker	Work with targeted families to improve <b>attendance</b> at school and provide support and <b>advice to parents</b> . Half termly drop-in sessions in school.	All year groups depending on need and targeted intervention	£10,502
Emotional Literacy Support Assistants (ELSA): support, resources and training	Purchase appropriate resources and provide training for ELSAs in order for them to: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• support identified children in the development of their <b>emotional literacy</b> (recognising emotions, self-esteem, social skills, friendship skills, anger management, loss and bereavement) so that they are then able to focus on their learning more effectively.</li> <li>• develop the <b>social and emotional skills</b> of individual or small groups of children to enable them to communicate more effectively with each other.</li> </ul>	All year groups depending on need	£16,548
Trained Volunteers from Epsom College (6 <sup>th</sup> form students)	Training for Epsom College students prior to supporting children. Develop <b>social, emotional and language</b> skills and more specific support to close the gap in attainment for vulnerable groups (e.g. ensure children stay focused and on task to enable progress across the curriculum.)	All year groups depending on need	£190
School trips and clubs	Enable children to attend educational day/residential trips and clubs to ensure full coverage of the National Curriculum and provide additional <b>extra-curricular activities</b> , so they can enjoy the same experience and opportunities as other classmates.	All year groups depending on need	£3990
