St Mary's is a Level 2 'UNICEF Rights Respecting School. We are committed to ensuring children's voices are heard at St Mary's. We strive to ensure that all 42 rights of the child are unconditional, inalienable and indivisible. Some children at our school have barriers to learning that mean they may require provision that is **additional to** and **different from** others. This may be termed as Special Educational Needs.
