### ATTENDANCE

Your child's attendance certificate is attached to this letter and shows attendance for the first third of the academic year.

We have a school target of above 96% attendance. And this is what we class as "good attendance".

Whole school attendance is currently 95.32%  
On the reverse of this letter is a reminder of the process we use when analysing attendance and making decisions about any next steps.

### KS2 CAROL CONCERT

Your help is very much appreciated.
