Dear Parents,

We have planned to take the children in Class 1 and 2 to The Collection Museum in Lincoln to take part in a Dinosaur and Fossil workshop. The visit will take place on Tuesday 9<sup>th</sup> January 2018. We intend to depart from school at 9:15am and return before the end of the school day.

Children will need to be dressed in their school uniform and a packed lunch will be provided for those who normally have a free school dinner.

If your child suffers with travel sickness please make Miss Jones or Miss Johnson aware of this. It would be advisable to administer the travel sickness tablet before they come to school and enclose another tablet for the return journey in a named envelope.

The cost of the trip will be £7.80 per child. This includes the cost of entry to The Collection Museum and a contribution towards the hire of the coach. These visits form an integral part of the curriculum and, as such, are extremely worthwhile. Unfortunately, such activities cannot be funded without voluntary contributions from parents. Parents are under no obligation and no child will be omitted because parents are either unwilling or unable to contribute. However, it must be stress that school funds are not sufficient to organise such visits without voluntary help and, therefore, may be cancelled.

It would be greatly appreciated if you would return the permission slip with payment to school as soon as possible (cheques should be made payable to *Tedder School Fund* please), and no later than Friday 15<sup>th</sup> December 2017.
