Who to see if concerned about your child

- ◆ Initially call in or arrange an appointment to see your child's class teacher
- ◆ If you feel the matter has still not been resolved arrange an appointment to see the Head of Year.
- ◆ If you would still like to take the matter further then an appointment with the Head Teacher should be arranged. If you are not happy with the outcome of this meeting a letter of complaint can be sent to the Chair of Governors via the school office.
