

Y1 Phonic Check Results - June 2017

Children at the end of Year 1 (aged 5-6) take part in a phonics screening check. This is a statutory assessment for all children in Year 1. It takes place week every June and is administered in school by the Year 1 class teacher. It comprises of a list of 40 words (20 real and 20 nonsense). The expectation from the Government is that pupils should achieve up to 32 out of 40 to reach the expected level.

The following table compares the percentages by phonics result for the school in 2017 with the national results for 2017.
