

Suggested Kit List - Castle Head-September 2015

This year, for the first time, as well as phones, we are not allowing the children to bring any hand-held games or tablets on the visit.

- 1 waterproof jacket
- 2 warm jumpers
- 5 T-shirts
- 3 pairs of tracksuit bottoms or similar
- 6 pairs of thick socks
- 6 pairs of sports socks
- 2 pairs of shoes or trainers
- 2 pairs of OLD trainers
- 2 pairs of shorts
- Night wear (teddy optional!)
- Swimwear
- Underwear for the 4 days (some will get wet!)
- Toiletries (no glass containers)
- *DEODORANTS MUST BE ROLL-ON AND NOT SPRAYS**
- Towel
- Slippers
- Plastic drinks container (clearly labelled)
- Sandwich box (clearly labelled)
- Sun cream
- Sunglasses
- Large labelled bin liner for wet clothes (ESSENTIAL)**
- £5 spending money maximum.** In addition, 5 x 20p coins for the phone calls your child will be allowed. The centre has a tuck shop which sells sweets, drinks and small souvenirs.

***The Y6 teachers will provide your child with a plastic money bag with a label on it for their phone and tuck shop money.**

Optional Items

- Camera
- Medication to be taken - please give this to a member of staff when you arrive at school on the day of the trip. It should be bagged and labelled with your name and dosage.
- Torch (will only be used on the night walk on day one!)
- And finally, don't forget to bring your clothes/equipment/CDs etc. for the talent show.**
