### Phonics Screening Check

Introduced as a compulsory assessment in 2012, the phonics screening check is designed to confirm whether pupils have learnt phonic decoding to an appropriate standard. It is intended to identify pupils who need extra help to improve their decoding skills.

The check consists of 20 real words and 20 pseudo-words that a pupil reads aloud to a teacher. All pupils are expected to take the check in Year 1 unless they haven't shown any understanding of grapheme-phoneme correspondences. Children who do not meet the standard in year 1 will take the screening check at the end of year 2.
