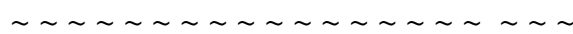

### **Severe Weather**

Details of the closure will be given to BBC Radio Leicester (104.9FM), to be broadcast on the radio and to be listed on their website, but it is often difficult to contact the radio station as there are so many schools trying to call in at the same time. If you think there is a chance that we may close, or open later than usual, please keep checking your mobile phone.

We will only close if absolutely necessary, but our first priority will always be to ensure the health, safety and wellbeing of staff, pupils and parents.

Where practical, we may decide to open an hour or two later, in order to enable staff and children to have additional time to travel to school safely.
