SCHOOL UNIFORM POLICY

The School is committed to safeguarding and promoting the wellbeing of all children, and expects our staff and volunteers to share this commitment.

Our School Uniform is important to us. It is one way in which we identify ourselves as a school family and it promotes a strong, cohesive school identity which supports high standards and expectations in all areas of school life. It promotes harmony between different groups represented in the school, and it enhances security, assisting the school to identify individual pupils in order to maintain good order and spot intruders more easily.

Smartness and high standards of appearance are expected at all times.

At Our Lady's Catholic Primary School, we believe that a school uniform is important, because it:

- Contributes to a sense of belonging
- Gives a common purpose
- Fosters a feeling of pride
- Reduces 'fashion competition' between children
- Looks smart
- Wears well

All children should wear school uniform and we encourage them to maintain an acceptable standard of clean and tidy dress in school. The uniform has been chosen after careful consultation.

Boys

Black shoes/trainers

Navy school sweatshirt with school logo
Black Trousers

White polo shirt with school logo/plain white polo shirt/white shirt and school tie

(short trousers may be worn after Easter instead of long trousers)

Girls

Black shoes/trainers

Navy school sweatshirt/cardigan with school logo

Black skirt/pinafore/trousers

White socks/black tights

White polo shirt with school logo/plain white polo shirt/white blouse and school tie

(Blue and white gingham dresses may be worn after Easter)

Indoor P E Kit – (Boys and Girls)

Black plimsolls

Black school shorts

White T-shirt

Outdoor P E Kit

Trainers

Plain black jogging/tracksuit bottoms

Plain black sweatshirt/tracksuit top

P E Kits should be kept in a P E bag. We discourage large bags as these are a safety hazard in the small cloakrooms. P E Kits are usually kept in school and sent home each half-term and end of term for washing.

Jewellery

Children may not wear jewellery to school. Anyone with pierced ears may wear studs during school time.

Please Note:

- Nail varnish is not permitted
- Extreme hair styles are not allowed (eg shaved heads or brands shaved into the hair, coloured hairsprays, large spikes with gel)
- All items of uniform/P E kit should be clearly named
