



# **Uniform Policy**

**Reviewed May 2016**

All pupils are required to wear uniform when attending school or when participating in a school organised event outside normal school hours. The Governing Body of the school determines the uniform policy and it is the responsibility of the principal and teachers to ensure that all pupils keep to the rules. It is the parents and pupils responsibility to arrive at school wearing the correct uniform and that it is appropriate for the weather conditions.

Wearing of a school uniform:

- Promotes a sense of pride in the school
- Is practical, smart and affordable
- Identifies students of the school and fosters a sense of community
- Promotes equality amongst the students in terms of their appearance

## **CEDAR LODGE UNIFORM**

### **PRIMARY**

- School sweatshirt – navy, green or purple
- Polo shirt – pale blue or white
- Grey trousers or skirt
- Black school shoes
- Girls – grey tights

### **POST PRIMARY**

- School blazer with badge
- School jumper – navy or purple
- White shirt
- School tie (clip on)
- Grey trousers or skirt
- Black school shoes
- Girls – white socks or grey tights

## **PE UNIFORM**

Pupils **must** change into PE uniform for sporting activities.

**PRIMARY** - White T shirt, navy shorts and plimsolls.

**POST PRIMARY** – White T shirt or pale blue polo shirt, navy shorts or navy jogging bottoms, purple hooded top and suitable training shoes.

## **SCHOOL BAGS**

Pupils must come to school with an appropriate sized waterproof bag for carrying school books and equipment. No school bags associated with any sporting teams are permitted in school.

## **JEWELLERY**

A wrist watch and 1 pair of stud earrings only

**\*No other items of jewellery or piercings are permitted.\***

## **ACCESSORIES, MAKE UP AND HAIRSTYLES**

No accessories to the school uniform are permitted. These include but are not limited to: sunglasses, hair decorations, wristbands, badges/brooches and hats.

Woollen hats may be worn to and from school in the winter but **must not** be worn inside the building.

Hairstyles should not be extreme in appearance nor of outrageous design, nor shaven. **All colour of hair is to be of a natural shade.**

**Excessive make-up is not allowed in school. Pupils may be required to remove excessive make-up before commencing school.**

Nail polish should be restricted to neutral shades and no false nails or extensions should be worn at any time.
