Europe

Year 4

Geography - Europe

Children will learn the countries of Europe, their capital cities and their flags. They will use maps and globes to investigate the different hemispheres and will learn to use grid references to locate specific countries in Europe. Children will also look at the physical features of Europe as well as the famous landmarks.

Science - Sound

Children will carry out various investigations as to how sounds are made, their pitch and volume.

Maths

Fractions: Recognise and show, using diagrams, families of common equivalent fractions. Solve problems involving increasingly harder fractions to calculate quantities, and fractions to divide quantities. Add and subtract fractions with the same denominator.

Measurement – Time and money: Convert between different units of measure, e.g. hour to minute. Solve simple measure and money problems involving fractions and decimals to two decimal places.

Number - Decimals: Recognise and write decimal equivalents of any number of tenths or hundredths.
