Knitting Club



Dinner and Sports Charges

NB: Charges for dinners and sports will not be available to pay via Parentpay this week, however charges will be as follows:

For the half term 9th January to 9th February inc

Dinners: Yrs 3, 4, 5 and 6: 24 days @ £2.10 per day = £50.40

Nursery children £1.60 per day + £1.50 care costs = £3.10 per day

Swimming: Yr 1 to Yr 6 £4 per week x 4 weeks = £16.00 (no swimming on 18th Jan)

Sport: Yrs 3 to 6 £1 per week x 5 weeks = £5.00

Adjustments: If you have any credits or debits for dinners from last term then please add or deduct from the dinner amount payable. Likewise if you have any debits or credits from swimming/sport then please deduct from the swimming/sport amount.


