Please use it to aid your own research or bring things into class to support your own learning. Our Christian value is Perseverance.

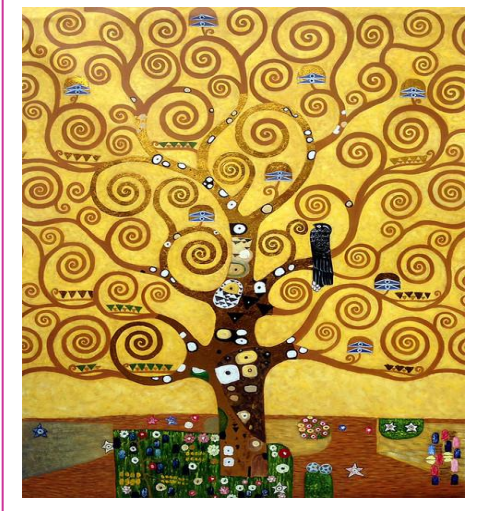
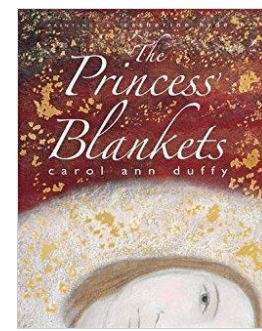
Children will be revising for their SAT tests this term. It would be great if parents could make sure homework is completed and children are reading regularly and practicing their times tables.

Explore why Exodus is such a significant event in the Jewish and Christian history.

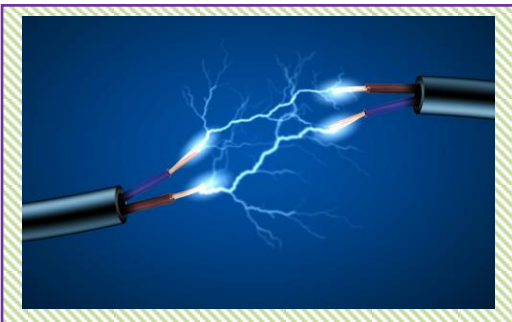
As Athletes we will:
