### **No Smoking/Vaping Policy**

#### **Aims**

- To guarantee a healthy working and learning environment and protect the current and future health of all members of the school community.
- To guarantee the right of non-smokers to breathe in air free from tobacco smoke.
- To provide non-smoking role models in the adults who teach and work in our school.
- To create a consistent learning environment by matching the ethos and behaviour within the school to the curriculum.
- To take account of the needs of those who smoke and to support those who wish to stop.

Health & Safety at Work Act requires that employers provide a working environment that is: “.....safe, without risk to Health”

#### **No smoking/vaping is allowed**

- 1** In the school building
- 2** On the school site
- 3** By any adult supervising pupils on school trips.

#### **Visitors/Contractors/Deliverers are required to abide by the no-smoking/vaping policy.**

#### **No Smoking Signs etc**

1. On school notice board outside school
2. In entrance hall of main school building.
3. Around the school site
4. No smoking policy is written in our school brochure.

#### **Recruitment Procedures**
