



In English...

We will be focusing story of Boudica and her rebellion against the Romans in Britain.
We will also be investigating non-chronological reports about the Celts and the Romans.

In Science...

We will learn about rocks and fossils. In this unit we will look at properties of different rocks and what they are used for. We will test different rocks and present our findings. We will also be investigating how fossils are formed over time.

In History...

We will be investigating the Roman Empire and the influence it had on Britain, both in the past and today. We will also be visiting Roman Vindolanda and the Roman Army Museum.

In Art we will be investigating Roman mosaics and creating our own mosaic through printing styles.

In Maths...

We will focus mainly on multiplying and dividing larger numbers (2 digit, 3 digit and 4 digit numbers by 1 and 2 digit numbers. It is really important that your child practices their times tables at home most nights as this will help them with these lessons.

We will also focus on measures, looking at perimeter, area and volume of shapes and containers.

Our theme for this term is the Romans. Our literacy, topic and PE lessons will be linked to this theme.

In ICT...

We will investigate different ways to present information using the I pads and the lap tops. We will focus a lot on improving our photography skills and incorporating photographs into apps such as Movie Maker, Book Creator, Comic Life and Explain Everything.



In Music...

we will develop our understanding of relationships and different types of relationships we have with different people/groups of people.

In PE...

Class 4 will develop their knowledge of Irish Dancing and this will be in preparation for a performance about a Roman Soldier who is trapped on the wrong side of Hadrian's wall and is being hunted by Celtic Warriors.
