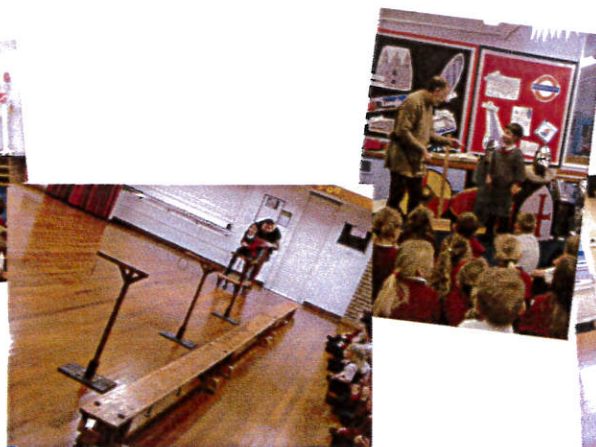
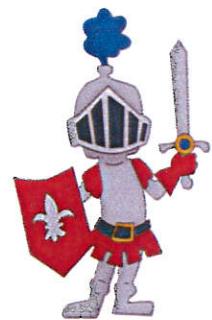
Another huge thank you to everyone for their hard work with the creative homework over the Christmas holiday.

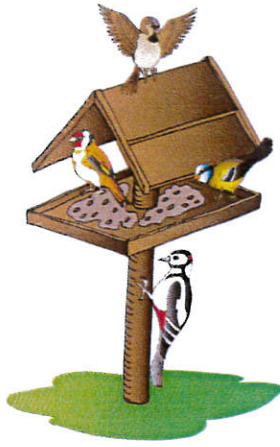
There are lots of exciting looking artefacts on display in the classrooms. We are looking forward to learning lots more about them from the children.
