

Maths

We will be focusing on:

- Counting and place value
- Reading and writing numbers to 20.
- Solving addition and subtraction problems.
- Fractions (whole, half, quarter)
- Time and Measures
- Sharing

Religious Education

We will take part in services in Church: Ash Wednesday and Easter.

The children will be considering questions such as "Who is Jesus" and "Is Easter happy or sad?"

Literacy

Key Texts - Fairy Tales (Spring 1) and Castles (Spring 2)
Using "Talk for Writing" children will learn the story and write their own version of Jack and the Beanstalk. They will explore features of other fairy tales including Cinderella, The Three Billy Goats Gruff, and The Gingerbread Man.

The children will learn to write character descriptions, lists, letters and instructions. They will have the opportunity to write their own stories. They will explore castles (see link with History)

Phonics will take place on a daily basis and children will be in differentiated phonics groups.

Geography

This links with History and the children will explore where castles were built and the reasons for this.

The children will identify and name a variety of common animals and find out whether they are carnivores, herbivores or omnivores. They will name and label the basic parts of the human body.
