In order to reduce the amount of lost learning time and so that learning is maximised (please see Ofsted Report 2017), we request that you choose your child's dinner with them at home. You can do this, in advance, online by logging on to [feedinghungryminds.co.uk](http://feedinghungryminds.co.uk), then go to "Select Menu". Select the date and then select your child's dinner by clicking on their chosen meal. You can do this weeks in advance but not on the day.



Please ensure you download the Parenthub app and turn notifications on. This is how school communicates with parents. You can log in to the App and see the notifications from school but to make sure you are receiving notifications through the App you need to be verified. To do this go on to [www.parenthub.co.uk](http://www.parenthub.co.uk), create an account and enter your telephone number. You will receive a four digit code by text, enter this and it will request the date of birth of your child at school. If you have any problems with this please call into the School Office.
