We will be basing our learning around a text and a film this term.

The Iron Man and Ride of passage.

We will have a big focus on spelling and sentence structure



Science

Maths

We will be learning to:

Recall and use multiplication and division facts
Solve problems using various mental and written methods

Telling the time to the nearest minute using an analogue clock with numbers and roman numerals, 24hr clock

Recording and comparing time

Use vocabulary such as night, day, noon, am, pm, midnight, morning, afternoon



PE

We will be focusing on fundamental movements
The children will learn how to balance, develop their coordination and become more agile. This will be achieved through a variety of games and skill sessions.
