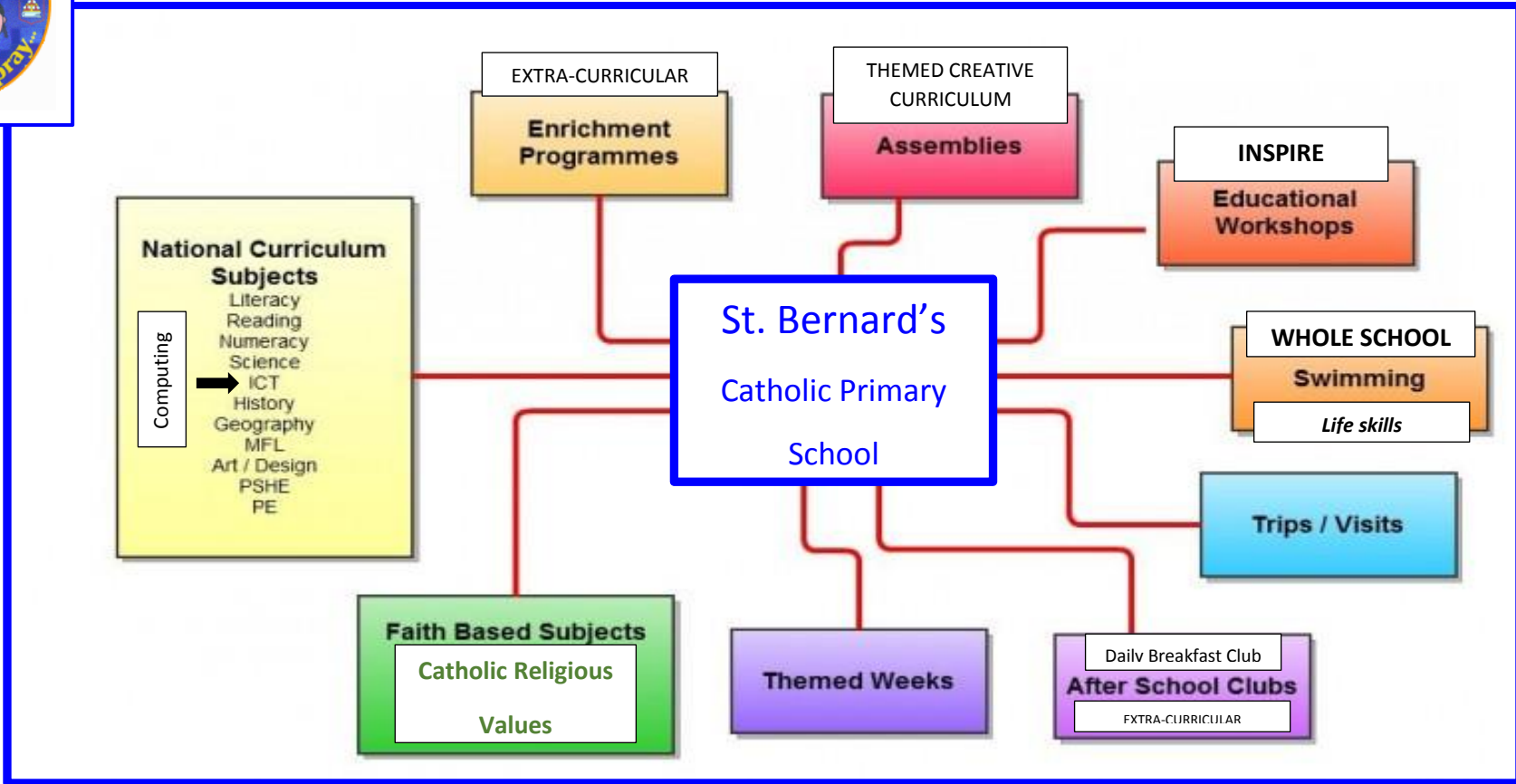


Whole School Creative Curriculum Approach
