Primary swimming sessions at Driffield Leisure Centre Swimming teacher and lifeguard (20 weeks)	£500	All Primary age children to have the opportunity to attend regular swimming sessions and lessons throughout the year to develop children's water confidence. Aim for 75% of year 6 pupils to be able to swim 25m unaided.
Professional development for staff	£1000	Supplied training opportunities for staff to develop their own skills to promote activity and sports for pupils.
Specialist coaching from Sports Clubs	£1800	To develop a wider knowledge base and take advantage of further opportunities to upskill staff in delivering PE and sport. Pupils will have the opportunity to experience new sports.
