## Pupil Premium Proposed Spending 2015-2016

This money will be used to:

- Fund an additional teacher in Y1 to enable the class to be split into two smaller groups to deliver English and Maths
- Fund additional HLTA support in Year 4 (class size 34) and Y2 to enable the classes to be split into smaller groups in order to deliver the whole curriculum and targeted interventions/boosters
- Fund additional TA support in Y6, Y2 and Y1 to enable the class to be split into smaller groups to deliver English, Maths and targeted interventions/boosters
- Fund a part-time teacher in EYFS and KS1 to deliver intervention and booster programmes for Phonics and Speaking and Listening interventions
- Fund residential, trips, workshops and school visitors providing opportunities to enrich the school curriculum and its impact on enjoyment and learning
- Weekly swimming lessons throughout the academic year for Year 2 & 3
- Continue to fund outdoor play equipment to enhance and support language and social development within the nursery and reception as well as play based learning and emotional development
- French lessons for Year 3, 4, 5 & 6
- Fund reading (Beanstalk) support for targeted children
- EWO one afternoon a week to continue to improve attendance
- Help fund staffing for the schools subsidised Breakfast Club
- Wider opportunities music tuition for all of Year 4 & Year 5 (violins)
- Wider opportunities music tuition for Year 2 (recorders)
- Wider opportunities music tuition for KS1 and KS2 (Choirs)

- Provide training for staff to deliver new intervention programmes and boosters
- Provide workshops by 'Liverpool Compact' for KS2 children

The impact on standards will be evaluated each term and a final evaluation published in 2016.

- Development of improved oracy skills in the EYFS
- Raised attendance
- Raised achievement
- Improved quality of teaching and learning
- Increased enjoyment, engagement and motivation
