Week 1	<p>Week 1 Explore</p> <p>To talk about own experiences and feelings about celebrations that they have experienced. (AT2 (i))</p> <p>To wonder about why people celebrate AT 2 (ii)</p>	<p>Look at a variety of pictures of Celebrations e.g. Bonfire Night, Birthdays, Christmas, Weddings, and Christening.</p> <p>Discuss different ways people celebrate. Who do we celebrate with how do celebrations make us feel?</p>	<p>Children draw a picture of a celebration. Add caption to explain what is happening.</p>
Week 2	<p>Week 2 Reveal</p> <p>To recognise the story of the presentation as a religious story. AT1 (i)</p>	<p>Introduce term Parish / Church family. Talk about some celebrations that happen in Church.</p> <p>Share story of the Presentation at the Temple.</p>	<p>Sort images related to weddings and Christenings.</p> <p>Completing speech bubbles of different people in the story.</p>
Week 3	<p>Week 3 Reveal</p> <p>To recognise that the parish family celebrate in particular ways. AT1 (iii)</p>	<p>Looking at how the Church Community prepares for Celebrations. Ask Mrs Swainston to talk about how they help.</p>	<p>Think up some questions as a group.</p> <p>Label pictures of different 'jobs' in church.</p>
Week 4	<p>Week 4 Responding</p> <p>To talk about own experiences and feelings about celebrations they have experienced. (AT2 (i)) To wonder about why people celebrate AT 2 (ii)</p>	<p>Ask the children what they wonder about.</p> <p>Why is celebrating important?</p> <p>What is good about celebrating together?</p> <p>Plan class celebration. Choose a song to sing and make a class prayer to share during Class Liturgy.</p>

Week 1	Week 1 Explore To talk about times they have gathered together and how they felt. AT2 (i)	Look at pictures of people doing things together. What do we do together at school? Take photos of things we do together make into class book. In continuous provision emphasis working together.	Children draw picture of a favourite activity they share with their family.
Week 2	Week 2 Reveal To recognise the words The Lord be with you. And with your spirit. To recognise the lectern and how it is used. AT 1 (ii)	Talk about how the parish family gather for mass. Look at pictures of people gathering being welcomed and listening to the word of God. Introduce the simple prayer response The Lord be with you.	Make a welcome to St Joseph's Church poster. Showing what happens at church.
Week 3	Week 3 Reveal To recognise the story of Jesus with the Children as a religious story. AT1 (i)	Tell the story of Jesus and the children. Explore what this tells us about Jesus. Link to how we gather to hear God's word and know we are loved by God. Talk to children about how they receive a blessing at church similar to in Mark 10.	Give Children picture of Jesus with the Children add speech bubble. What is Jesus saying to the children? How do the children feel?
Week 4	Week 4 Respond To talk about how and why people gather together to celebrate Mass.	Why do we gather together? How do we celebrate God's love? How do we gather as a Church family?	Teach the children a Gathering Song eg This is the day.

Week 1	<p>Week 1 Explore</p> <p>To recognise growth in nature and discover the ways in which things grow.</p>	<p>Plant cress and record changes in different conditions eg with water, in the dark</p> <p>Look for signs of growth in school grounds.</p> <p>Key Questions</p> <p>How do things grow?</p> <p>What do things need to grow?</p> <p>How do I grow inside?</p>	<p>Keep a record of the growth of the cress in zig zag books</p> <p>Take photographs and annotate them showing signs of Spring.</p>
Week 2	<p>Week 2 Reveal</p> <p>To learn about Lent: a time to grow more like Jesus</p>	<p>Talk about Lent being a time when we grow in love, goodness, helpfulness just like Jesus.</p> <p>Read Luke 2:51,52</p> <p>Use pictures from Church story 1 pg 40-41 Label how the children are living as Jesus asked us to.</p> <p>Brainstorm ideas for how we could grow more like Jesus during Lent.</p>	<p>Make Lenten promise cards display on Lenten tree</p>
Week 3	<p>Week 3 Reveal</p> <p>To recognise the story of Good Friday and getting ready for Easter</p>	<p>Place a Cross draped in a purple cloth on the prayer focus.</p> <p>Talk about Good Friday using <i>God's Story 1</i> page 34 or <i>Church's Story 1</i> pages 42-43. Ask: What do you see? The Cross is special because it helps us remember Jesus' great love for everyone.</p>	<p>Draw a cross on a hill</p> <p>Label picture – Jesus died on a cross.</p>
Week 4	<p>Week 4 Respond</p> <p>To reflect on how we can grow during Lent</p>	<p>Talk about how we have grown in love during Lent. Refer back to Lenten Promises.</p>	<p>Make an Easter card to take home.</p>

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
