For just writing alone, Year 6 teachers are required to assess all children against 24 writing objectives across six pieces of work - this totals 144 assessments to be made per child just for writing! As I know you will appreciate, teachers' marking and assessment and subsequent planning and preparation of resources takes a huge amount of time, is of high priority and allows very limited time to offer more information on top of what is already provided).
