The theme for this year's parade is paintings. Each school chose a painting out of a hat to create their individual theme. Our painting is 'The Tilled Field' by Joan Miro.

Toddlers/non-St Peter's children are also welcome at the school workshops (but please note that we do not have a crèche). **Please do try and come to the workshops and support us! We must have parental help in order to take part.** If you are unable to attend any of these dates there is also the opportunity to help us work on costumes/props from home. Please let me know if this is of interest to you. As well as the after school workshops, there will be a whole school two day **Art Festival ~ 'Marvellous Miro' taking place on Monday 26<sup>th</sup> March and Tuesday 27<sup>th</sup> March**. If you are able to come and help in your child's class, please let the class teacher know. During this festival, we will be making and decorating animals, making flags and learning more about the artist Joan Miro, as well studying some of his famous paintings.

We must know how many children/adults are participating in the parade, as we are restricted to numbers and therefore it is not possible to just turn up and join the parade on the day.
