Keep the children occupied during the February half-term holidays with a range of activities at Jigsaws Childcare in Church Fenton. Our 'out of school' club offers a safe, caring and fun environment for your child, while our range of half term activities will give them lots to enjoy, a chance to meet new friends and learn new skills.

Activity sessions run from 9.30am to 11.30am and cost £8 per session. * There is an extra £2.50 charge to use the woodland for each Forest Schools sessions. If you have not used Jigsaws before, we would need you to complete a record form when booking. Payment for booked activities is expected before 22nd July to secure places and ensure the correct ratios of staff to children.
