Summary of PPG spending 2011/12

Objectives in spending PPG:

- To support our most vulnerable pupils and families.

Summary of spending and actions taken:

- £300 was spent on 10 pupils to attend the Children's University 8 week course at Herts College. Boost self-esteem and develop new creative skills.
- £500 paid for additional sports coaching to support the school football team. Impact - competed at the Stevenage Borough academy regional competition. Met first team Stevenage Borough players. Great team building.
- £700 towards cost of residential trip, enrichment activities to bring learning alive.
- £800 additional teaching time to target identified groups to boost literacy and Maths.
- £1380 towards the cost of ICT software - Maths Whizz for interactive whiteboards. 2 Simple software for all curriculum areas.
- £1200 Sporting Futures subscription – additional coaching for netball, basketball, cricket, hockey, tag rugby and football.

Outcomes to date for the targeted group:

- 80% made outstanding or good progress in Literacy and Maths
- 20% made satisfactory progress in Literacy and Maths
- Football and netball clubs now competing in an inter-village league. The school has competed in the Stevenage tag rugby, cross country, dragon boat racing and dance festival competitions.
- Targeted pupils self-esteem and confidence in different social and learning environments noticeably improved.
