Free school Meals

Your child might be able to get free school meals if you get any of the following:

- Income Support
- income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- the guaranteed element of Pension Credit
- Universal Credit

Although children in years Reception, 1 and 2 are eligible for the 'Universal Infant Free School Meals' we can still claim for the free school meals too. In addition to meal provision this comes with further funding for the school to support the children's learning.

It is very simple to apply and is completely confidential so, if you think you may be eligible please see Mrs Greig.
