### Child Absence

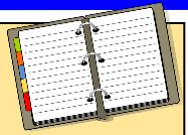

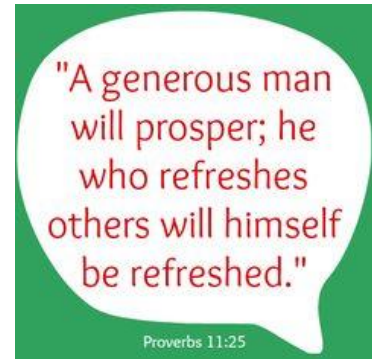
