- I didn't realise how involved the children were in assessing their own and other pupils' work.
- Maths - Strategies for calculation often change which make it challenging for parents to support children as they often confuse children regarding appropriate strategy as we use how we were taught when in education. (School comment: Many parents/carers indicated on the evaluation form that they would appreciate information about how we teach maths. We ran workshops for maths three years ago now so we feel new workshops would be helpful and we can include plenty of new information also. We will plan maths workshops for the summer term in response to the feedback from parents. In the meantime, we have videos on the maths page of the website, with our pupils demonstrating our calculation methods for addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. You can find these at:
