As a family we will:

-  Encourage our children to attend school regularly unless not well enough to do so
-  Inform school of the reason for absence
-  Share with school anything that may affect our children's work or behaviour
-  Inform school of relevant medical information and changes in medication, including allergies
-  Ensure that any prescribed medication that is required to be given in school, will be handed directly to the escort on transport or handed directly to a member of the school nursing team. We will NOT put any medication in our children's school bag
-  Attend Annual Reviews, Medicals and Parents' Evenings whenever possible
-  Encourage good behaviour
-  Give the school up to date contact details (mobile phone, addresses)
-  Follow guidance given by school and health staff (e.g. our children to be kept at home following stomach upset for at least 48 hours after last episode)
-  Avoid taking family holidays during term time
-  Adhere to Complaints Policy
-  Write in the home-school diary, reply to letters sent home and complete homework where appropriate
-  Not write about sensitive issues in the home-school diary but contact school directly
-  Not complain via the home-school diary but follow the complaints procedure
-  Not share photos or videos of other people's children online (e.g. Facebook)
-  Agree that any photographs or videos we may take to record school events will be for personal/family use only
