Welcome back to all Year 6 children.

In addition to daily Literacy and Numeracy lessons, the topics being studied this term include:

History - Britain since the 1930s – focusing on the causes and implication of World War2, life in Britain during the war including evacuation; the Home Front; and how the local area was affected.

Art – Remembrance week art gallery. 'Poppies'

DT – Food Technology 'Rationed Recipes'

Science – Blackout blinds, and light (Aut1), The Human Body (Aut2)

R.E. – Sikhism – customs and beliefs visit Guhdwara.

Computing – We are App planners - Research into types of Apps, handling data and App design. E/safety

P.S.H.E – New beginnings – Focusing on self-belief and setting personal challenges, the benefits and group work as well as rules, rights and responsibilities.

P.E. All classes will develop through multi skills, as well as developing net and ball games skills. Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday.

Children need both indoor and outdoor PE kit in school for both lessons.

Spelling homework is set and tested on Fridays. Children are expected to read daily so they can complete Accelerated Reader quizzes daily at school. Children are expected to go on '**Number Gym**' regularly and progress through levels. There are topic based projects to complete termly.

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IJS Year 6 Curriculum – Summer 2018

Welcome back to all Year 6 children.

In addition to daily Literacy and Numeracy lessons, the topics being studied this term include:

Topic –Related to our Whipsnade Zoo Trip.

Art – **Perspective in Art** – the children will be exploring one and two point perspective. Using this they will draw a bedroom and cityscape followed by an 'illusion' art piece using perspective.

DT – Linked to our science topic we will be investigating periscopes.

Science – **Light** – the children will discover how light moves, and how the eye senses light. We will then move onto studying shadows, reflection and refraction as well as different colours and carrying out our own investigation. Human body and Circulation.

R.E. – **Stories of Faith** – what can we learn from stories shared by Christians, Jews and Muslims? Specifically exploring the stories of Adam and Eve, Noah, Jacob and Joseph in Genesis.

Computing – **Web design** – making your own website.

P.S.H.E. – New beginnings – Focusing on self-belief and setting personal challenges, the benefits and of group work as well as rules, rights and responsibilities

P.E. – All classes will learn the basic skills of tennis, as well as developing their skills in team games such as rounders.
