<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Read the first 100 High Frequency words from the Reception list. • Use phonic knowledge to decide regular words and read aloud accurately. • Identify rhymes and join in with rhyming patterns. • Read and understand simple sentences. • Demonstrate understanding when talking with others about what they have read. • Make basic predictions. • Identify start and end of a sentence eg capital letters and full stops. • Know sounds and names of alphabet. • Read Set 1 and 2 RWInc. • Blend words with Sets 1 and 2 sounds. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Write 3 simple sentences which are phonetically plausible and can be read by themselves and others. • Use capital letters and full stops to demarcate sentences. • Write name (correct upper and lower case). • Use finger spaces. • All letters formed correctly beginning with a lead into the letter. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Count objects to 10 then to 20. • Recognise numerals to 20. • Order numbers 1-10, then to 20. • Say 1 more/1 less to 20. • Add and subtract two single digit numbers. • Begin to recognise number bonds to 10. • Count on/back from any number 1-10. • Use simple mathematical vocabulary. • Know some 2D/3D shapes – circle, triangle, square, rectangle. • Write numbers 0-9 accurately.
