Nature of support 2016-17

The funding received from pupil premium has been allocated in the following ways:

- Increased higher level teaching assistant support to increase targeted support in phonics, reading, writing and maths, including lower ability and high ability pupils
- Opportunities for all pupils to have access to computers during targeted interventions
- Payment for attendance at clubs, music tuition, theatre visits, residential trips and educational visits and visitors for FSM and Ever 6 pupils

Future plans for 2016-17

The funding received from pupil premium has been allocated in the following ways:

- All of the above
- Increased learning resources including computer access that they may not have available at home, especially iPads
- Use of funding for targeted support in interventions or extended learning as appropriate
- Additional training for staff as necessary

Impact

During the academic year 2016-17 based on teacher assessments and national tests against national curriculum criteria and average points scores:

- Children with FSM or Ever 6 made at least expected progress in reading, writing and maths. This highlights the impact of targeted spending in raising standards for pupils
