Y4 Visit to Yorkshire Wildlife Park

As part of Y4 topic 'Wild and Wonderful' next term we will be taking our Year 4 children to visit The Yorkshire Wildlife Park. This will be an exciting and stimulating end to our topic.

The visit will take place on Tuesday 20th March 2018. We will leave school at 8.45am. We would therefore like the children to arrive at school and be in their classrooms by 8.30am. We are hoping to arrive back at school at 4pm.

A text message will be sent to you in the event of a delay in the return time.

Payment in full for school visits this year should have already been paid. If you haven't already paid please ensure we receive your payment as soon as possible. Thank you to all who have paid.

Please ensure that if your child does suffer from travel sickness that they have taken their tablet before coming to school to avoid distress on our journey. If your child requires a tablet for the return journey please send it in an envelope labeled with your child's name and clear instructions as to when it should be taken.

A packed lunch will be required, (no glass bottles please), although if your child has free school meals, lunch will be provided by school. School uniform should be worn along with a waterproof coat and comfortable shoes. The children will not require any spending money for this trip.
