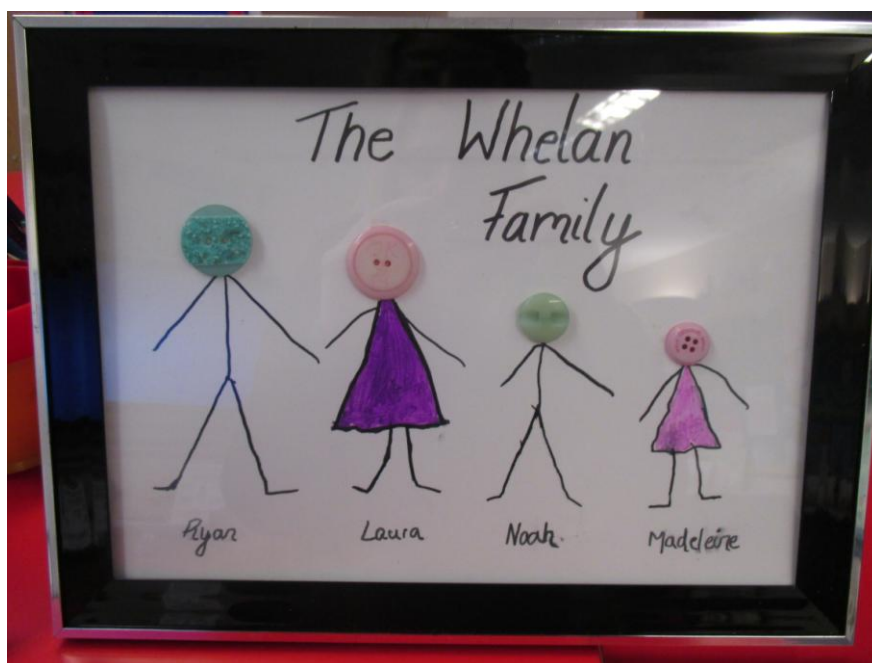
Due to lack of helpers to support **KABS** the **film night** this Thursday is now cancelled.
