School Uniform

We promote the wearing of school uniform to give children a sense of belonging and pride in our school. We ask parents to support us by encouraging their children to come to school tidily and suitably dressed.

- **Sweatshirts, jumpers or cardigans** in navy;
- **Shirts, tee shirts, or blouses** in a light blue or white;
- **Trousers, skirts and pinafore dresses** in grey or navy; (Leggings are only acceptable in very cold weather)
- **Summer dresses** (striped, checked or plain) in light blue or navy;
- **Summer shorts** in grey or navy;
- **Socks or tights** in white, navy grey or black only;
- **Sensible footwear** - shoes (black) or sandals (black, brown, blue or white) (NO TRAINERS). In very cold or wet weather children may wear boots or wellingtons to school, changing into suitable footwear at school.

PE Kit Sports or athletic shorts/skirts navy blue, tee shirts white/pale blue, socks, trainers. Trainers may be worn by KS2 for outdoor activities, during the winter months please ensure that your child has either plain tracksuit bottoms or leggings (Navy or black) and a tracksuit/sweatshirt top. The PE kit should be in a separate kit in a PE bag.

Hair accessories. Long hair should be tied back using striped, checked or plain ribbons or scrunchies in light or navy blue.

Outdoor clothes – Wellies, waterproof jacket and waterproof trousers. Classes will be informed when they need these items for outdoor learning.

Please make sure that all your child's clothing has his or her name on and that your child knows where to look for their name.

Sweatshirts, cardigans, polo shirts and PE T-shirts are available for sale from the school office. There is an order form on the school website. In addition, there is a direct link to our uniform suppliers to enable parents to buy uniform online at their own convenience.

Nail varnish and jewellery

We request that children do not wear coloured nail varnish at school. A small watch and simple pierced earrings may be worn. However, earrings must be removed or taped over before PE lessons. Children need to be able to remove their own earrings.
